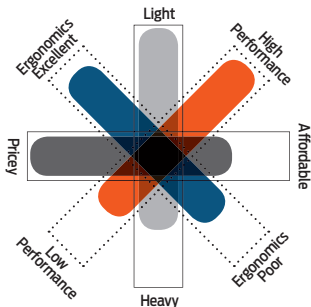

FEATURES

Atomic's venerable T2 is no more, but taking its place is the more nitrox-friendly T2x. This solid-billet-titanium super breather comes with a factory-sealed first stage and a low-pressure port swivel turret. The second stage even sports titanium Comfort Swivel (which we loved). It also has a seat-saving orifice and uses Atomic's Automatic Flow Control, a depth-activated venturi control. Work of breathing barely changes from a moderate breathing rate at 20 feet to a heavy breathing rate at 200 feet, and in the ocean the T2x provided smooth, dry performance in all swimming positions, along with minimal bubble interference and a powerful purge.

Bottom Line The T2x is the Rolls Royce of regs, with top-drawer performance, exotic metalwork and lots of cool features.
